Labuan, Peninsular Malaysia, Sabah and Taiwan	<p>Require import permit and phytosanitary certificate, the suckers or the source of material had been obtained from designated area for planting materials which are free from the following quarantine pests:</p> <p><b>Insects</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• West Indian cane weevil (<i>Metamasius hemipteru</i>)</li> <li>• White grub (<i>Leucopholis irrorata</i>)</li> <li>• Mealy bug (<i>Plenacoccus madeirensi</i>)</li> <li>• Thrips (<i>Thrips tabaci</i>)</li> <li>• Pineapple mite (<i>Steneotarsonemus ananas</i>)</li> </ul> <p><b>Nematode</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Root-knot nematode (<i>Hemicriconemoides mangifera</i>)</li> </ul> <p><b>Diseases (Bacteria)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pink disease-bacteria (<i>Acetobacter aceti</i>)</li> <li>• Pineapple pink fruit-bacteria (<i>Pantoea citrea</i>)</li> </ul> <p>Suckers are to be dipped in 0.1% metalaxyl + 0.1% cypermethrin or in any equivalent insecticide or fungicide at recommended rate for 15 minutes.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Fumigation with methyl bromide 100% at 24 g/m<sup>3</sup> for 2 hours.</p>



Pineapple suckers of 10 suckers or less (per passenger), can be brought into Sarawak without the need of import permit and phytosanitary certificate, but inspections will be conducted thoroughly.
